09 APRIL 2018 – 30 JUNE 2025

The outcome of the cases handled by the Independent Police Complaints Commission for the period **09 April 2018 to 30 June 2025** are as follows:

No. of complaints received	No. of investigations completed	No. of complaints still under investigation
4,921	2,838	2,083

During the period from 09 April 2018 to 30 June 2025, the Independent Police Complaints Commission (IPCC) has received **4,921** complaints, out of which, **2,083** are still under investigation and **2,838** have been completed as follows:

- **2,014** complaints have been disposed of after investigation in line with section 10(4) of IPCC Act 2016
- **513** complaints have been withdrawn by complainants;
- **250** complaints have been resolved through conciliation meetings conducted by the Commission;
- **53** complaints have been referred to the Office of the Director of Public Prosecutions (ODPP) for advice for prosecution, out of which:
 - 19 complaints have been lodged in Court (*18 cases are still at the level of the Court and one case has been dismissed*);
 - 2 cases required no further action; and
 - 32 cases are still at the level of ODPP
- **8** complaints have been referred to the Disciplined Forces Service Commission for disciplinary action

- Delay in enquiry by police;
- Failing to attend request made by public;
- Search warrant not shown before carrying out a search;
- Damaging private property during police operation;
- Threat by police;
- Harassment by police;
- Abuse of Authority; and
- Alleged larceny by police during search carried out by them.
